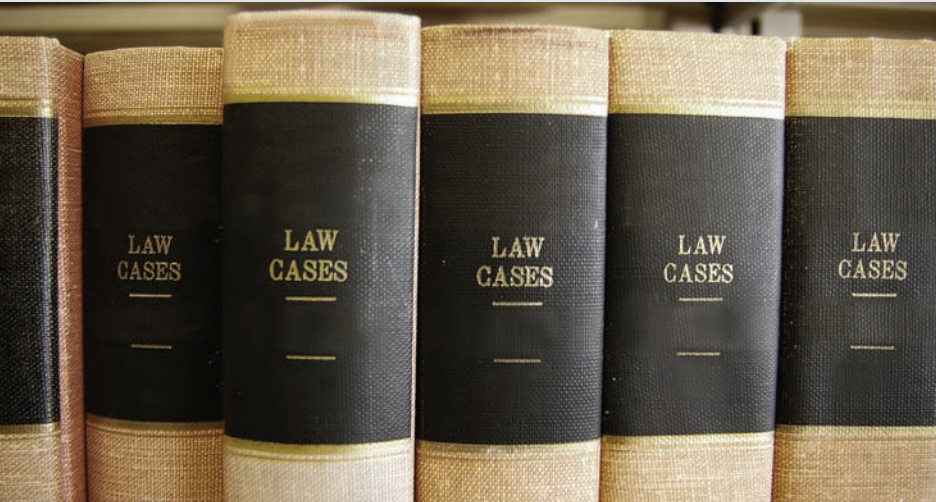

## Parenting | Kenneth Proudman
