

#### Intersection of Constitutional & Insolvency Law | Prof. Thomas Telfer

Trace the historical evolution of the relationship between constitutional law and insolvency law, and identify the wide variety of contexts in which these areas of law intersect.

#### Introduction to Division of Powers Jurisprudence | Prof. Eric Adams

Review the division of powers jurisprudence, including the paramountcy doctrine as it has been shaped by recent SCC decisions.

#### The Scope of the Discharge after Moloney | Dr. Anna Lund

Consider the scope of the discharge in personal bankruptcy following the SCC's decisions in *Alberta (Attorney General) v. Moloney* and 407 *ETR Concession Co v. Canada (Superintendent of Bankruptcy)*.

#### Regulatory Powers | Terry Czechowskyj

Analyze the constitutional issues that arise when regulators take steps to enforce their powers against insolvent corporations, including recent examples from Alberta.

#### Receivership | Prof. Rod Wood

Explore the implications for receivership law in light of the SCC's decision in Saskatchewan (Attorney General) v. Lemare Lake Logging Ltd.

#### Priorities | Prof. Ron Cuming

Examine how the priority ranking of creditors in insolvency proceedings has been shaped by constitutional doctrine.
