## **Balancing Tribunal Openness & Tribunal Privacy | David Loukidelis QC**

Consider the delicate balance that must be struck in administrative tribunal proceedings subject to *FOIP*: the balance between a fundamental principle of Canada's justice system – openness of proceedings and decisions – and a fundamental individual right – the right to privacy.

## **Information and Privacy from the Frontlines | Jill Clayton**

Discuss topical developments in privacy law with an Information and Privacy Commissioner. Examine recently issued investigation reports, orders, and guidance documents as well as emerging issues and trends.

## **Cybersecurity: Strategies to Minimize Risks | Roland Hung**
