Imputing Income to Determine Child Support Payable: An Overview and Update

Review the law relating to applications that involve the imputation of income. Discover tips for applications using prior year income in calculations, retroactive claims in circumstances where income has dropped dramatically, and more.

Review Clauses in Spousal Support

Determine when review clauses are appropriate. Explore best practices for structuring these clauses when used on a consent basis and factors that affect contested review order applications.

Applying For and Responding to Interim Spousal Support Applications

Unravel the mystique and understand the “science” behind the elusive Application for Interim Spousal Support. Gather practical tips for use in both seeking and defending against interim spousal support applications.
