Personal Property Security and Debt Recovery Essentials

First Steps: Providing Early Advice in Financing Transactions | Michael Morcom

Discuss early structuring advice prior to a credit decision; due diligence searches, including practices regarding title and off title searches in relation to land; practices to address competing registrations and third party priority agreements and/or postponements; and more.

Making the Right Decision on Enforcement Options | Rick T.G. Reeson QC

Explore the various options that are available to a secured creditor, including remedies under the *PPSA*, receivership, and the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*. Get tips on combining various remedies available under different legislation.

New and Emerging Developments Under the PPSA | Prof. Rod Wood

Identify important legislative developments in personal property law, and discuss several recent judicial decisions. Discover fundamental concepts of secured transactions law and how a proper understanding of the *PPSA* can significantly reduce risk.

Federal Tax Claims | Michael J. Lema

Review the Canada Revenue Agency's principal recovery mechanisms and the "debts of equal degree" prerogative. Analyze recent decisions exploring their operation in various contexts. Examine the extent to which taxpayer information is available from the CRA.

Secured Debt and the Civil Enforcement Act | Prof. Tamara Buckwold

Explore important points of interface between the *PPSA* and judgment enforcement law. Focus on priority and creditor ranking in distribution.

Recommendations for Effective Registration and Searches | Kevin Bauer

Effective registrations and searches require identification of debtors and collateral consistent with the requirements of the *PPSA*. Review key points of comparison among jurisdictions, including important differences in registry behaviour and recommendations for effective registration and search practices.
