Q WHAT IS A FLIPPED CLASSROOM?

A flipped classroom is an instructional strategy that flips the traditional learning environment. This alternative model delivers instructional content online in advance, freeing up in-person time to focus on higher-level, active learning activities. Benefits of flipped classrooms include:

- Learner-centred emphasis
- Increased engagement
- Skill development
- Application of knowledge to real-world situations

PART 1: Pre-Program Learning (Before October 4, 2018)
